Stamped Designs Cat Crazy Cards



Meow You Doing Card

Distress ink used: Stormy Sky

- 1. Assemble the cat with wet glue.
- 2. Using the pawprint stencil and Stormy Sky Distress ink, stencil the blue circle.
- 3. Attach the stripes to tan card as shown with wet glue, then layer to the dark brown piece, then to the front of the base card.
- 4. Attach the blue circle as shown, then attach the cat piece with foam squares.

White Cat Card

Distress ink used: Festive Berries, Pumice Stone

- 1. Apply Pumice Stone ink to the edges of the top cat piece. Layer to the solid white piece. Piece the gold glitter and pink pieces in the eyes, ears and nose areas as shown.
- 2. Apply Festive Berries ink to the 2 paper bows and heart piece, then assemble the bows with wet glue.
- 3. Assemble the green pocket piece by applying adhesive to the flaps for the sample, I put the bottom flap outside on the back of the piece to keep the slide out card from catching on the edge at the bottom.
- 4. Attach the striped piece to the front of the green pocket piece, the attach the cat piece with foam squares. Attach the bow and heart with a foam square and the gold sequins with wet glue.
- 5. For the center tag piece, layer the white piece to the pink piece, then attach to the tag. Add the ribbon through the tag hole and then add the ribbon bow.

You Are Purr-fect Card

OLO markers used: WG-0/1/3, R 2.2, YG 1.2, BV 1.2, O 2.4, Y 2.2

1. Color the cat and butterflies with the markers listed.

- 2. Layer the dark blue stripe to the light blue piece with wet glue. Layer to the blue dot piece, the attach to the front of the base card.
- 3. Attach the cat and butterflies with foam squares as shown.
