Thinking of You Card

Distress ink pads: Fired Brick and Frayed Burlap

- 1. Using a foam dauber, apply Fired Brick ink to the left side of the red mushroom tops and Frayed Burlap to the stems. Assemble the mushrooms as shown with wet glue.
- 2. Using scissors, wave cut the small piece of taupe card, then layer to the lower half of the light blue die cut piece. Layer to the black die cut piece.
- 3. Layer the embossed piece to the black piece then to the front of the base card.
- 4. Layer the die cut layered piece as shown, then attach the mushrooms as shown. The large mushroom the back is attached with wet glue and the other 2 with foam squares.
- 5. Attach the words piece with foam squares.

Hello Card

Distress Ink pad: Frayed Burlap

- 1. Apply Frayed Burlap ink to the cream colored mushroom pieces. Build the mushrooms as shown with wet glue.
- 2. Layer the green piece to the large black piece, then to the front of the base card.
- 3. Layer the plaid piece to the small black piece, then attach to the card.
- 4. Attach the mushrooms with foam squares.
- 5. Attach the red strip as shown and then the hello piece with wet glue.

Hello Card

Distress ink pads: Peacock Feathers and Brushed Corduroy

- 1. Stencil the light teal piece with the diamond stencil and the Peacock Feathers ink. Layer to the black piece and then to the front of the base card.
- 2. Apply Brushed Corduroy ink to the mushroom stems. Assemble the mushrooms with wet glue.

- 3. Attach the blue oval to the front of the card, then position the leaf piece as shown and attach with wet glue.
- 4. Attach the mushrooms with foam squares.
- 5. Stamp the hello word as shown.
